

# Is Your Artwork “Print Ready”?

Here is a quick check list to make sure that your files are ready to print:

## BASIC FILE SETUP

- Make sure all pages in the file are the same size and orientation. If your job requires multiple page sizes, please include them in separate documents.
- Add a bleed of 0.125” on all edges of all pages.
- Extend all artwork to the bleed lines.
- Keep all non-bleeding items at least 0.125” away from the trim line.

## REMEMBER TO:

- Delete any unused objects from the document.
- Turn on all document layers so that everything is visible.
- Run a spell check before outlining all fonts.
- Make sure all images are at least 300 dpi and in CMYK.

## LAST BUT NOT LEAST:

- Make sure the document you supply is saved as a PDF.
- Double check that everything looks correct in the print file you supply.
